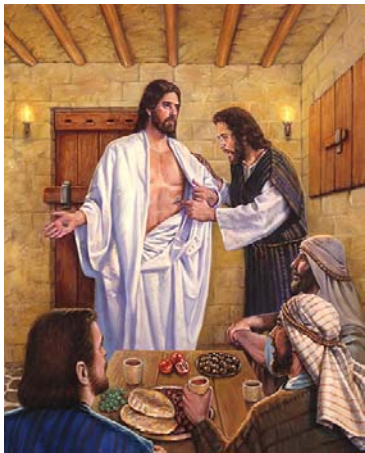

Both clients are close to sixty years old and we are working with them to get them on various wait lists for subsidized housing. Unfortunately, the wait times can be up to 4-5 years. 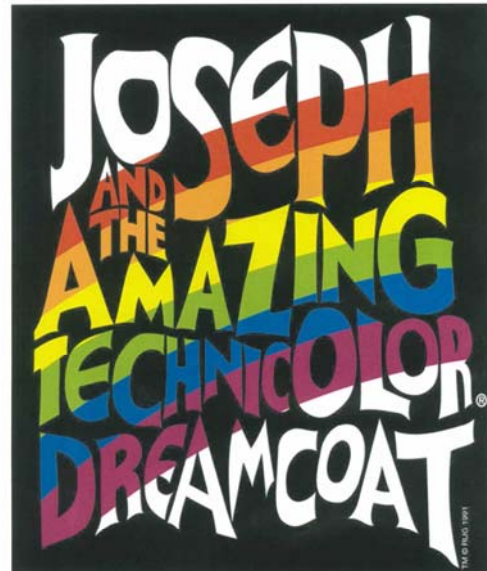

Applications welcomed for position of Development Coordinator

The Bishop's Task Force is a committed group of local volunteers leading the renewal of St. Joseph Catholic Elementary School on our Sutherland Avenue site. With over 4 years of work behind them, the Task Force is moving towards initiating and completing this project in the near future. To assist, the Task force is welcoming applications for the role of Development Coordinator.

Reporting to the Bishop's Task Force, the Development Coordinator will oversee the various steps needed to complete a fundraising campaign for St. Joseph's renewal. Leveraging efforts through a team of coordinated volunteers, the Coordinator shall ensure a sufficient number of qualified donors are identified, engaged and encouraged to participate in the campaign. The campaign's successful completion, it is anticipated, will also establish a template and mandate for ongoing capital development within the Diocese of Nelson.

Successfully engaging donors and actively informing our Catholic community will be critical for this campaign's success. Accordingly, the Development Coordinator will be expected to manage relationships with School Administration, Parishes, Pastors, Diocesan contacts and key community groups. The Coordinator will be the primary contact and overseer for volunteers, third party vendors and administrative supports (if and as needed).

The Coordinator should be comfortable working independently while remaining accountable to the Task Force's vision and objectives. A candidate's professional or educational background should demonstrate strong communication and organizational skills along with success in meeting specified goals within an established timeline. Completion of an undergraduate degree, college diploma or advanced industry designation is preferred. This role shall be offered by contract and include an initial probationary period.

This important opportunity rises at an exciting time in our community and provides the chance to have an incredible impact on Catholic Education's local future.
