## SOCIAL JUSTICE

### ST VINCENT DE PAUL UPDATE



This month we have seen Clients with a wide variety of challenges including dealing with a brain injury, fighting addiction, recovering from a dehydration, stay in hospital while pregnant, coping with cancer, and working with our members to try to move to affordable assisted living apartments. During our visits members are often confronted with clients searching for a sign that God has not abandoned them or a way in which to surrender to their faith putting their full trust in God during their difficult challenging times.

During client visits our members draw from the spiritual reflections and discussions shared at our meetings to offer support and encouragement to clients. Currently we are looking at the Pope Francis' Encyclical Lumen Fidei (The Light of Faith).

We have a member recently returning from the regional meeting of the Society in Vancouver. Our member returned with information on St. Vincent Youth Conferences. These meetings are valuable sessions during which information is shared. The National Annual General Assembly is coming up in June.

This month's collection saw a timely very generous donation. Your donations enabled the society to maintain its financial commitments to Local, National and International levels. In addition to the hampers delivered weekly, financial support was given to Ozanam House. Internationally money was sent to National Council that will be forwarded to help the St. Vincent de Paul in Nepal. We continue to send money to a conference in Haiti.

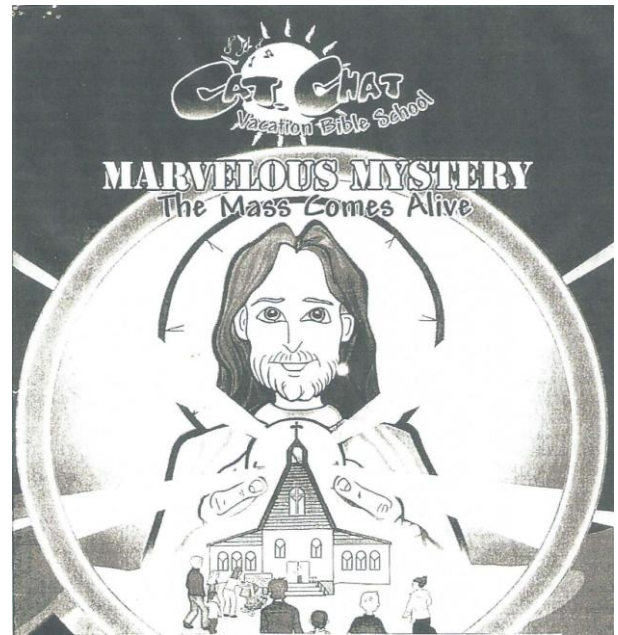
